

Cindy Bee's Sew Along 2024

Bargello Sampler - Borders

Cutting:

Fabric 1 (inner border)	Lap: Cut (6) strips 2 ½" x WOF Queen & King: Cut (5) strips 3" x WOF for side borders Cut (4) strips at 2 ½" for top & bottom borders
Fabric 8 (second border)	Lap: Cut (6) strips 2 ½" x WOF Queen & King: Cut (5) strips 3" x WOF for side borders Cut (5) strips at 2 ½" for top & bottom borders
Fabric 7 (outer border, or third border for king size)	Lap: Cut (7) strips 3 ½" x WOF Cut (7) strips 2 ½" x WOF for binding Queen: Cut (9) strips 4" x WOF Cut (10) strips at 2 ½" x WOF for binding King: Cut (5) strips 5" x WOF for side borders Cut (5) strips at 4 ½" x WOF for top & bottom borders Cut (11) strips 2 ½" x WOF for binding
Fabric 6 (outer border for king size)	King: Cut (5) strips 6 ½" x WOF for side borders Cut (5) strips 6" x WOF for top & bottom borders

Depending on your fabric you can chose to sew the border strips using either a diagonal or a straight seam to create one long piece. Sew border strips into one long unit.

Side Borders

- Measure the quilt from top to bottom through the middle. Cut 2 borders to this length. Fold the border to find center, mark with a pin, fold once more to find and mark quarters. Repeat this process on the quilt top. Pin borders to the sides of the quilt, matching centers, edges and quarter marks. Ease in any fullness. Sew. Press seams towards border.

Top and Bottom Border

- Measure again through middle from side to side, including the previously added borders. Cut top and bottom border to this size. Pin to top and bottom, matching centers, edges and quarter marks. Ease in any fullness. Press seams towards border.

Repeat for subsequent borders.

Always sew your binding strips using a diagonal seam & press seam open.
