

# Roll & Flip Reversible Tote

Sizes: small 16 ½ x 15", large 16 ½ x 19"

<b>Fabric</b>	<b>Small</b>	<b>Large</b>
Main	12" x 36" (0.35m)	16" x 36" (0.45m)
Lining	12" x 36" (0.35m)	16" x 36" (0.45m)
Cuff	9" x 36" (0.25m)	9" x 36" (0.25m)
Handles	7" x WOF (0.2m)	7" x WOF (0.2m)
Flange	3" x 36" (0.1m)	2 ½" x 36" (0.1m)
Fusible Interfacing	For 20" width: 1.15 m For 45" width: 0.65m	For 20" width: 1.15 m For 45" width: 0.65m

Handles: take your 7" x WOF piece and trim off the selvages, then cut in half by trimming off the centre fold. You should now have 2 pieces that are 7" x half your original width of fabric.

Fusible interfacing cut 1 piece 9" x 36", and 2 pieces the length of your handles less a ½". (For example, if my handles measure 21" long after trimming them up, I would cut the interfacing 20 ½" long. The length of your handles will depend on the width of the fabric you choose, or your personal preference, so I cannot give an exact number here.)
