

## Alternate Block: Nine Patch Chain

**Note:** fabric is calculated at 40" wide, if your fabric is 42" wide, you may need less strips.

## Light fabric: twin (queen)

Cut 6(13) strips 4 ½" x wof, subcut into 48(100) 4 ½" squares Cut 7(13) strips 2 ½" x wof, Subcut only 2(3) strips into 28(40) 2 ½" squares.





## **Dark Fabric:**

Cut 3(5) strips 4 1/2" x wof

Subcut into 20(36) 4 1/2" squares

and 2(2) 4" squares , cut once on the diagonal


Cut 1(1) strip 7 ½" x wof,

subcut into 3(4) 7 ½" squares, cut twice on diagonal Cut 5(10) strips 2 ½" x wof

Save remaining fabric for 1<sup>st</sup> border

Note: 4-patch measures 4 ½" x 4 ½" You will need 34(100) Block measures 12 ½" x 12 ½"

You will need 6(16) full blocks, 10(16) half-blocks for the set-in triangles and 4 corner units.



Make 10(16) Half blocks Set-in triangle unit
