

Using layout on following page, sew row 2s to row 3s, then add set-in triangles to ends of row pairs. Sew row 4 to row 5, then add set-in triangles to one end of row pairs.

Then, sew row 6 onto one of the row 5s, stopping a few inches short of the end. On the completely sewn end of this row 4-5-6 combo, add one of your $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x $16 \frac{1}{2}$ sashing pieces.

Sew the remaining row 5 to row 6 completely & add one of your 2 ½" x 16 ½" sashing pieces to the end of this row 4-5-6 combo. Next, go back and complete your partial seam.

Then sew your row 1s to row 2s, and row 3s to row 4s.

You can then sew the corner triangles on all four sides to complete the quilt centre.

Hint The edges of the set in triangles will not line up exactly, only make sure the seams line up & your pieces lay flat. Your edges will be a little jagged, we will be trimming the quilt centre next week.
